- Red zones are not accessible (going through is not allowed)
- Pink zones are accessible for pedestrians only





# **METRO ACCESS**

All access to/from rue Froissart, rue Archimède and rond-point Schuman are closed. We recommend you step in/out at Maalbeek station.

From then, walk to ACE events.

  - Exit at Maalbeek metro station
  - Walk to ACE events (see itinerary above)
